

Surgical Rep (UK)

GASOC is seeking a UK Surgical Representative who is passionate about sharing knowledge and experience to improve surgical outcomes in low- and middle-income countries. As an advocacy group we are seeking applicants who are passionate about promoting global surgery locally and worldwide. Applicants must have a training/ clinical fellow post in one of the surgical specialties. Applicants would be expected to develop and maintain links with the UK Royal Colleges and surgical societies, whilst working closely with the Irish and International Surgical Representative for Ireland in promoting collaborative partnerships and organising events such as Journal Clubs. An ideal candidate will have experience working with or within surgical teams in low- and middle-income countries, and strong social media, leadership and organisational skills.

Essential: This post is open to UK-based applicants who are post-foundation training and have a confirmed Core Surgical/Higher Surgical training post or a clinical fellow role in a surgical specialty. There are basic requirements for all committee members to be involved in voting for decisions relating to GASOC and contributing to the annual GASOC Conference, these will be discussed at handover.
